

MEMORIAL/FUNERAL ATTENDANCE PROTOCOL DURING THE PANDEMIC

1. Criteria of Admittance:

- a) Hand sanitizing upon entrance into the building.
- b) Masks must be worn at all time while in attendance.
- c) Social distancing of at least 6 feet shall be maintained (except as indicated under sitting arrangements below).
- d) Attendance log, temperature monitor shall be maintained for the purpose of contact tracing.

2. Recommended Sitting Arrangement:

- a) Vaccinated parents, grandparents, children and those under a household may sit together for better occupancy of the pews.
- b) Those that have completed vaccinations may sit together with less than 6ft space provided we can trust each other with the facts of vaccination (records).
- c) When mixing with others in the building, wear masks and keep the 6ft social distancing from others.
- d) Maintaining the 6ft social distancing will be difficult during eating. It's recommended that a minimum of 3ft separation be adhered to.
- e) The family can remove their mask while eating and resume use after eating.

3. Use of Microphone During Remarks:

It is absolutely recommended that mics be wiped down with sanitizer wipes after each user for safety.

4. Seating Capacity:

If the above sitting arrangements and sanitizing procedures can be kept, we may be able to accommodate 100-125 attendees.

Note: One shot of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine only gives 80% guarantee per CDC. However, completed two shots gives 90% guarantee of not being infected or spreading the virus.
